REV. CHARLES NELSON SPAULDING, D. D.
First Rector of Howe School

DEATH OF
THE REVEREND CHARLES NELSON SPALDING, D.D.,
FIRST RECTOR OF HOWE SCHOOL.

The Reverend Charles Nelson Spalding, D.D., first Rector of Howe School, died at the Episcopal Hospital, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, November 21, 1914. He was the last of four brothers eminent in the Church's Ministry, their father also being a Priest of the Church. The brothers were Drs. Henry, Erastus, and Edward Spalding.

Dr. Spalding was born April 20, 1836, at Phelps, New York. He graduated at Hobart College, Geneva, New York, in 1857. He was Professor of Mathematics at Shelby College, Kentucky, in 1858. He studied at the General Theological Seminary, New York City, until the Civil War when he enlisted in the 55th Reg. N. Y. Volunteers as a private, in 1862. He served nine months and was in the battles of Williamsburg, Fair Oaks and Malvern Hill, and in several severe skirmishes.

Before his ordination he was Master at St. Paul's School, Concord, N. H., then in the formative stage of its history. In 1863 he was made Deacon by The Right Reverend Jackson Kemper, D.D., LL.D., and in 1872 Priest by The Right Reverend John Barrett Kerfoot, D.D., LL.D. In 1865 he accepted the rectorship of St. Paul's Church, Evansville, Indiana. In 1867 he was elected Professor of Mathematics in Racine College. In 1871 he was Secretary of the Diocesan Board of Missions, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. In 1872 he was Rector of Christ Church, New Brighton, Pennsylvania. During this rectorship he built St. Mary's Church, Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania. In 1876 he, with his brother Edward, founded Trinity School, San Francisco, California, January 6, 1876, he married Miss Mary Hewetson Appleton, who survives him with two daughters, Miss Caroline Spalding and Mrs. Walter J. Douglas. In 1881 he was Rector of St. John's Church, Lancaster, Pennsylvania. During his rectorship the church was enlarged and many improvements made. In 1884 he was called to assume the rectorship of the Diocesan School of Indiana, at Howe, Indiana. This position he resigned in 1895. In 1890 he received the degree of Doctor of Divinity from the Nashotah Theological Seminary. He also held rectorships at St. Luke's, Wheeling, West Virginia, where he was the means of building the church; Laurel, Delaware, during which rectorship he built a church at Delmar, Delaware; and St. Mark's, Pleasantville, New Jersey.

Dr. Spalding was a scholar of unusual ability. As a preacher he was forceful and edifying, in parish work he exemplified a notable missionary zeal. As an administrator he was especially successful in organizing parish and school work and materially equipping the same. Howe School will always be indebted to him as its first rector for laying the foundations wisely and well and in giving zealous and energetic service in the formative period of the school.

To the Alumni of Howe School

At the Annual Meeting of the Alumni of Howe School, in June, 1914, it was suggested that our Association take out a policy of \$10,000 on the life of the Rector, having previously gained the permission of those who have subscribed to the Alumni Endowment Fund. The suggestion was carried into action and the annual premium on policy is \$511.40. We have at present, in sight, a yearly income of \$250.00, and very little effort on the part of those Alumni, who are not already contributors, will make up the deficit.

This move, I know, will prove beneficial because we now have a more definite work to accomplish. Previously, members of the Alumni and friends of the School were given several optional methods of subscribing to the Endowment Fund, and while it is not our purpose to discourage the past methods of contributing or discontinue them, you will agree that the single purpose idea of meeting a certain obligation each year, is a most satisfactory and desirable way.

If you will glance over the list of the Alumni in the accompanying pages, you will note that Howe men are becoming representative in the professional and business world. Surely this is a good foundation upon which to build a strong Association, and it should encourage us to recognize these great possibilities.

For thirty years the school has prospered because of good management. Its success is due for the most part to our good friend, the present Rector. He has weathered the storms of stringent financial conditions at times when other well organized and well managed schools have been forced to close their doors. He has done all this without the assistance of an organized Alumni, because the graduates of the school were too young in business to give financial support. But now that we have a start in the world it behooves us to consider well that our success, however small, is due largely to the educational benefits derived at Howe School. It is well, at this point, to recognize the fact that only through the efforts of the Alumni can the future success of the school be assured. A healthy Alumni Association, rendering substantial aid, means continued success to our Alma Mater.

It is difficult to measure Dr. McKenzie's worth to Howe School; in fact, it is impossible to place any monetary estimate upon his value. As much as we dislike to think of it, we know that he will not always be able to continue his good work and the money which we would receive from this insurance policy would be only a partial substitution for such a great loss.

Let us think of our Organization as growing in strength; that each year we add to our list of contributors some fellow who has not been able to give something, the year previous. Let us also appreciate the fact that the Endowment Fund is not made up by large amounts from the few of the wealthy or more successful of our number. Out of a number exceeding 300, who are able to make some sacrifice, however small, our desire of obtaining \$300 more each year, will be realized. In this way each one of us is doing his share toward a greater work—the accomplishment of our purpose.

In conclusion, let me exhort the members of the Alumni to take it upon themselves, individually, to make some contribution **this year**. You should not defer it, and I know you will not delay the proper action, if you will only stop to consider the worthy cause we have undertaken.

The Mothers' Chapel

The Mothers' Chapel is at last an accomplished fact. It was consecrated on All Saints' Day by the Right Reverend John Hazen White, D. D., Bishop of the Diocese of Michigan City, and President of the Board of Trustees. We were specially gratified to have Bishop White consecrate the new Chapel as he has consecrated every building during the present Administration. The Bishop's health has been very much broken and we specially appreciated the effort he made to be here for that occasion.

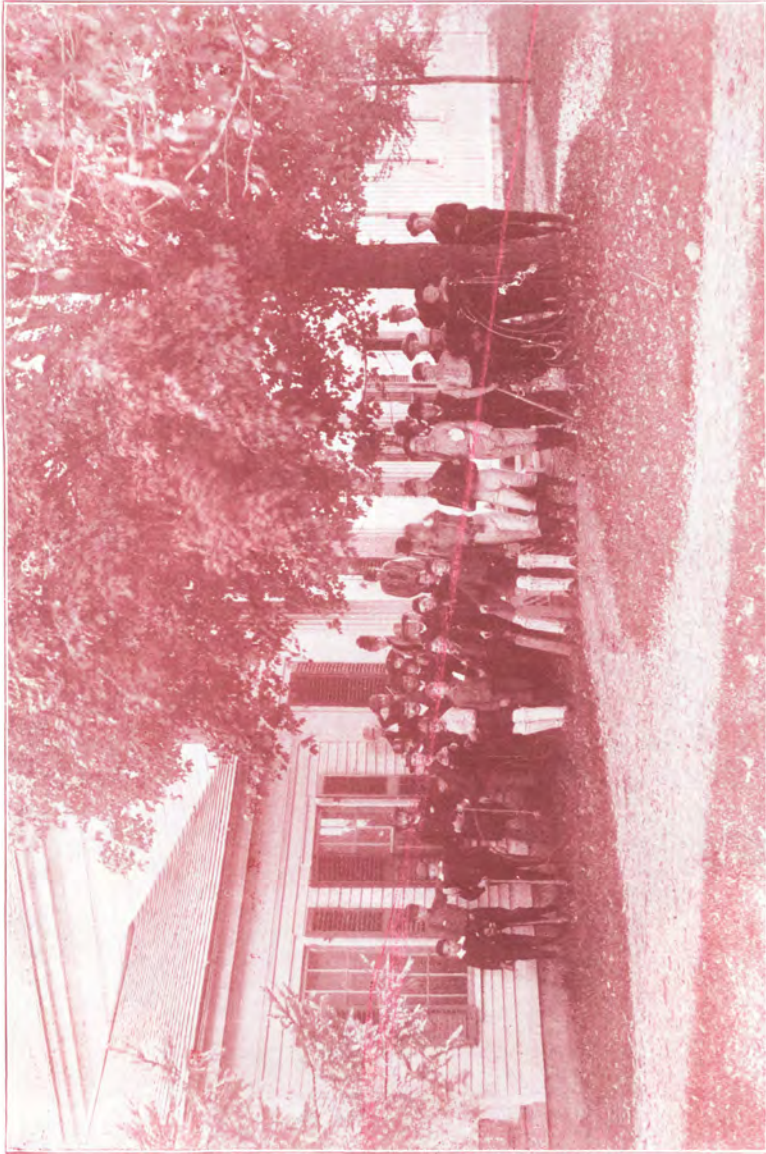
The New Chapel constitutes a South Transept. This completes the Chapel as originally designed. This addition will seat fifty on occasions. It is furnished with a beautiful Altar, donated by the St. Mark's Guild. Above the Altar hangs the Sistine Madonna which was presented to the Rector by Mrs. Howe. It is a very fine copy, made in Dresden, when Mr. and Mrs. Howe were visiting there in 1874. There is a very fine Crucifixion Group over the west door, which the Rector purchased upon his last visit to Oberammergau, in the summer of 1913.

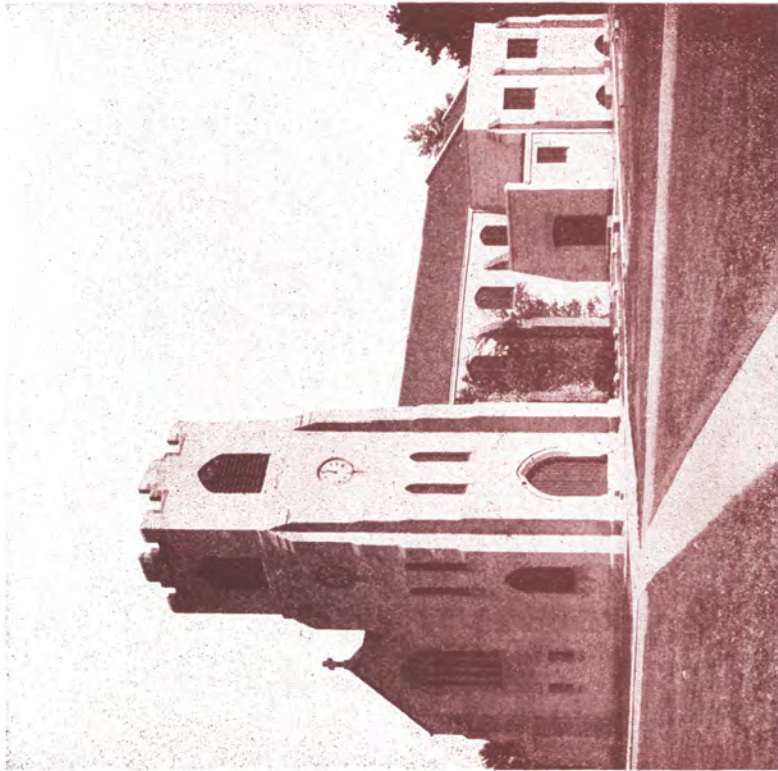

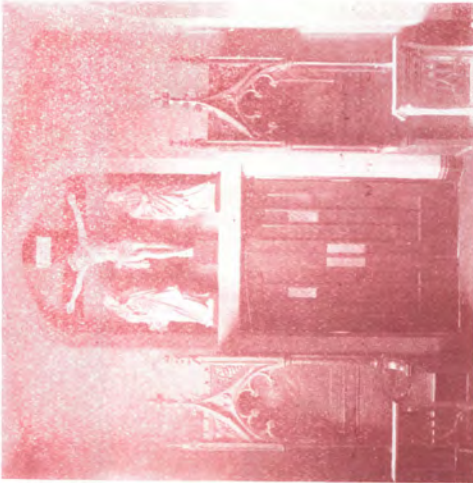

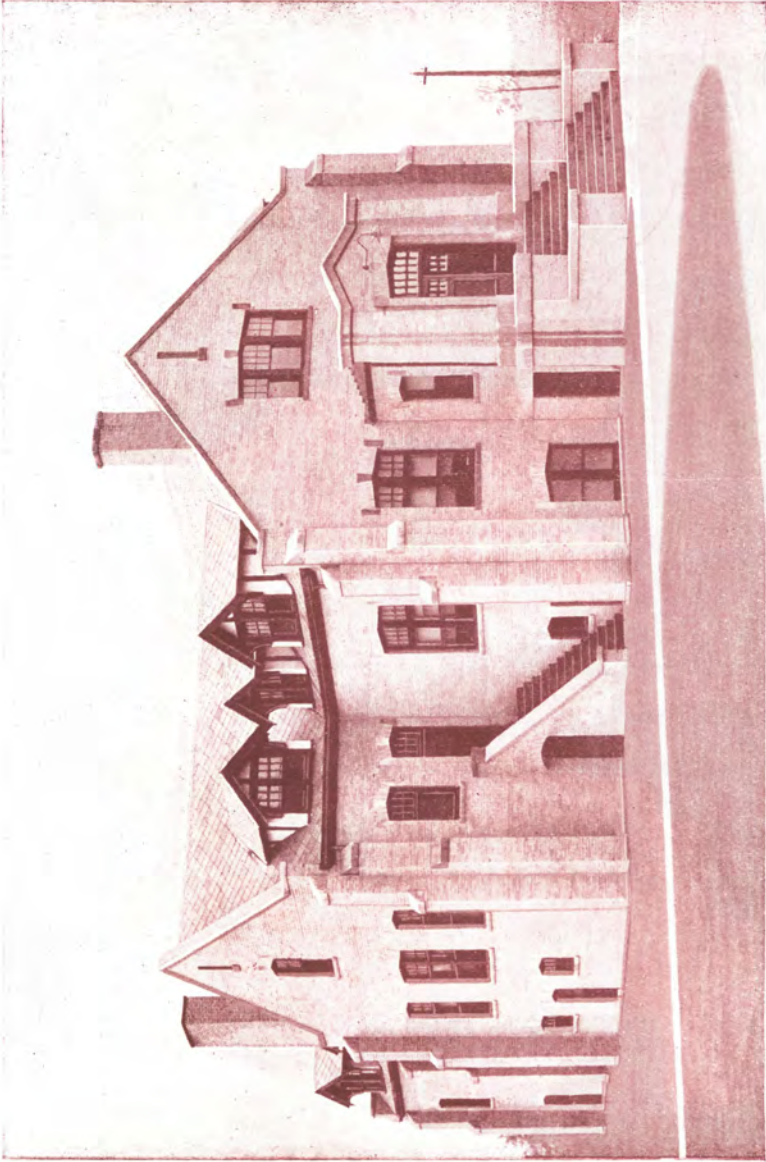

—CONSTITUTION—

Article I. The name of this Association shall be: The Alumni Association of Howe School.

Art. II. The objects of this Association shall be: To preserve the memories and associations of the past; to strengthen the tie which binds to a common Alma Mater; as well as to further the interests of Howe School.

—BY-LAWS—

Article I. The officers of this Association shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, and a Treasurer.

The President shall preside at all meetings of the Association and at all meetings of the Executive Committee.

The Vice-President shall act for the President in the absence of the latter.

The Secretary shall notify the members of the Association of the dates of meetings, shall conduct the correspondence of the Association; and shall preserve the minutes of the meetings of the Association.

The Treasurer shall have charge of all funds of the Association.

Art. II. The Executive Committee shall be composed of the officers of the Association together with three members elected for one year by the Association. The Committee shall have general charge of the affairs of the Association.

Art. III. The officers of the Association and the members of the Executive Committee shall be elected annually, at the business meeting of the Association, which shall be held each year on Commencement Day, at Howe School, Howe, Indiana.

Art. IV. Qualifications for Membership. All graduates of Howe School, as well as Honorary Graduates of that institution shall be eligible to membership in this Association.

Art. V. Meetings. An annual business meeting of the Association shall be held on Commencement Day, at Howe School, Howe, Indiana. Meetings for social purposes shall be arranged from time to time by the Executive Committee.

—CONSTITUTION—

Article I. The name of this Society shall be the Howe Club of Indiana.

Art. II. The objects of the Club shall be to foster a spirit of good fellowship among former students of Howe School in Indiana; to strengthen their social relations, and to advance the interests of the School.

—BY-LAWS—

Article I. Section 1. The officers of the Club shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer.

Sec. 2. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Club and at all meetings of the Executive Committee.

Sec. 3. The Vice-President shall act for the President in his absence.

Sec. 4. The Secretary shall give notice of all meetings, and shall conduct the correspondence and preserve minutes of the meetings of the Club.

Sec. 5. The Treasurer shall collect all dues and have custody of all funds of the Club. He shall render a report of the finances of the Club at each regular meeting of the Executive Committee, or whenever such report is requested by the Executive Committee. He shall pay all indebtedness of the Club, upon vouchers signed by the President and Secretary.

Art. II. The Executive Committee shall be composed of the President, Vice-President, the Secretary, the Treasurer and two members elected for one year from among the members of the Club. This Committee shall have general charge and direction of the affairs of the Club. The Executive Committee shall also constitute the Committee on Membership, and shall have power to elect members of the Club by an affirmative vote of four members of the Committee.

Art. III. The election of officers of the Club and the members of the Executive Committee shall be held annually at the business meeting which shall follow the annual dinner of the Club. The election shall be by ballot, and a majority vote of those present shall be sufficient to elect.

Art. IV. The Club shall hold an annual dinner on New Year's Day, at Indianapolis, unless otherwise determined by the Executive Committee.

Art. V. Any graduate, or any person who has been a student of Howe School, and has left in good standing, or any person who is, or has been connected with the School in any official capacity, shall be eligible to membership.

Art. VI. The entrance fee shall be one dollar (\$1), and the annual dues one dollar (\$1), payable on December 1st in advance.

Art. VII. Besides the annual meeting for the election of officers, and the annual dinner, there shall be such other social meetings of the Club as shall be determined by the Executive Committee.

Art. VIII. Any member of the Club failing to pay dues for two successive years, shall be held to have resigned. Such member may be reinstated on payment of back dues.

Art. IX. The By-Laws may be changed or amended by a majority vote at any annual meeting of the Club.

—CONSTITUTION—

—Article I—

The name of this Club shall be The Howe School Club of Harvard University.

—Article II—

The primary object of the Club shall be to bring into friendly contact those men in the University who have attended or are actively interested in Howe School; and to promote the affiliation of Howe School with Harvard University.

—BY-LAWS—

—Article I—

Section 1. The officers of the Club shall be a President, a Vice-President, and a Secretary and Treasurer. The officers shall be elected at the second meeting of the club each year, which meeting shall, if possible, be held on the third Friday of October.

Sec. 2. The president shall call all meetings of the Club, and shall preside at all business meetings. The President shall be a member of the Executive Committee ex-officio, and shall preside at the meetings of that committee.

Sec. 3. The Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President in the latter's absence.

Sec. 4. The Secretary and Treasurer, as Secretary, shall give notice to members of all meetings of the Club, shall preserve the minutes of all meetings of an official character, as well as all records of the Club, and shall conduct the correspondence of the Club. As Treasurer he shall collect all dues and shall have charge of all funds, and shall pay all debts of the Club upon the recommendation of the Executive Committee. He shall, upon the request of the Executive Committee, present to that body a statement of the finances of the Club.

—Article II—

Section 1. The Executive Committee shall be composed of four members of the Club. Three of these shall be elected annually at the second meeting of the Club each year. The President of the Club shall be the fourth member of the Committee and shall preside at all its meetings.

Sec. 2. The Executive Committee shall be vested with the general control and direction of the affairs of the Club. All matters of expenditures shall especially be subject to the control of the Committee.

—Article III—

Section 1. Members of the Club shall be either active or honorary.

Sec. 2. Any member of the University who has attended Howe School or is actively interested in the School may have his name presented as a candidate for active membership.

Sec. 3. Honorary membership may be conferred upon any person to whom the Club sees fit to award that mark of its esteem and appreciation.

Sec. 4. The names of candidates for membership, either active or honorary, shall be presented at a regular meeting of the Club. A secret vote of all the members shall be taken upon each name. For active members three black-balls shall exclude. For honorary members, one black-ball shall exclude.

—Article IV—

Section 1. The active members of the Club shall pay five dollars (\$5) a year dues before November first of each year.

Sec. 2. Any member who shall fail to pay dues shall be notified by the Secretary and Treasurer of the amount he owes. If he then fail to pay the amount within thirty days, he shall be held to have resigned from the Club, and shall cease to hold a member's privileges until his dues shall be paid to date.

Sec. 3. Active members shall be liable to an assessment of not more than \$10 at the end of each college year, if such assessment is found necessary.

—Article V—

Section 1. Business meetings shall be called when the President sees occasion, or when a request for such meeting, signed by five members of the Club, shall be presented to him.

Sec. 2. If possible two Club dinners shall be given each year, the place to be decided in each instance by the Executive Committee and the date by vote of the Club.

Sec. 3. Other meetings of the Club, for purpose of social enjoyment, shall be called at times when the Executive Committee shall deem expedient and at places to be decided upon by that Committee.

Sec. 4. A quorum, which shall consist of a majority of the Club, shall be necessary for the transaction of business.

—Article VI—

These By-Laws may be added to, changed, or amended at any regularly called meeting of the Club, upon a vote of a majority of the total membership of the Club.
